Academic Results

ESK's Class of 2022 have once again achieved superb International Baccalaureate and A-level results, maintaining the ESK tradition of academic excellence!

A-Level Results

ESK students continue to achieve superb results in a breadth of subjects! Due to the inflating of global results during a challenging COVID period, there has been a global drop in the average percentage of top grades, such as A* and A grades. However, at ESK we have emphatically bucked the trend.

Academic Results

The highest grade of 4A*s was achieved by 1 student. Not to mention, a stunning 72.7% of our students received A* - A grades in Turkish— as an English-speaking school, this result is truly exceptional!

IB Results

ESK's IB cohort of 2022 have once again achieved superb International Baccalaureate results, maintaining the ESK tradition of academic excellence!

The average IBDP score was 0.7 higher than last year, at a grand total of 37.7 IBDP points - the best in the history of the school! The global average is only 32 points. Our highest score was 40 IBDP points (out of 45), achieved by 2 students. This superb result can be compared to, and is in fact higher than A*A*A*A* at A-levels.

Not to mention, A very impressive 71% of our students achieved 39 points or above. This score is typically only achieved by 18% of all IB students worldwide. This year's results place ESK fourth amongst small cohort IB Schools (less than 20 students in cohort) in the UK, and at par with some of the leading Independent schools across the world, such as Charter House (UK), College du Lemman International School (Switzerland) and The British School of Milan (Italy).

Year upon year it is heartening to witness the placements of our students at top-tier universities, including USA Ivy League, Princeton University (ranked 7th in the world) and University of Pennsylvania (ranked 13th) and leading institutions in the world including the University of Edinburgh (30th), King's College London (35th) McGill University (44th) and Utrecht University (69th).*
